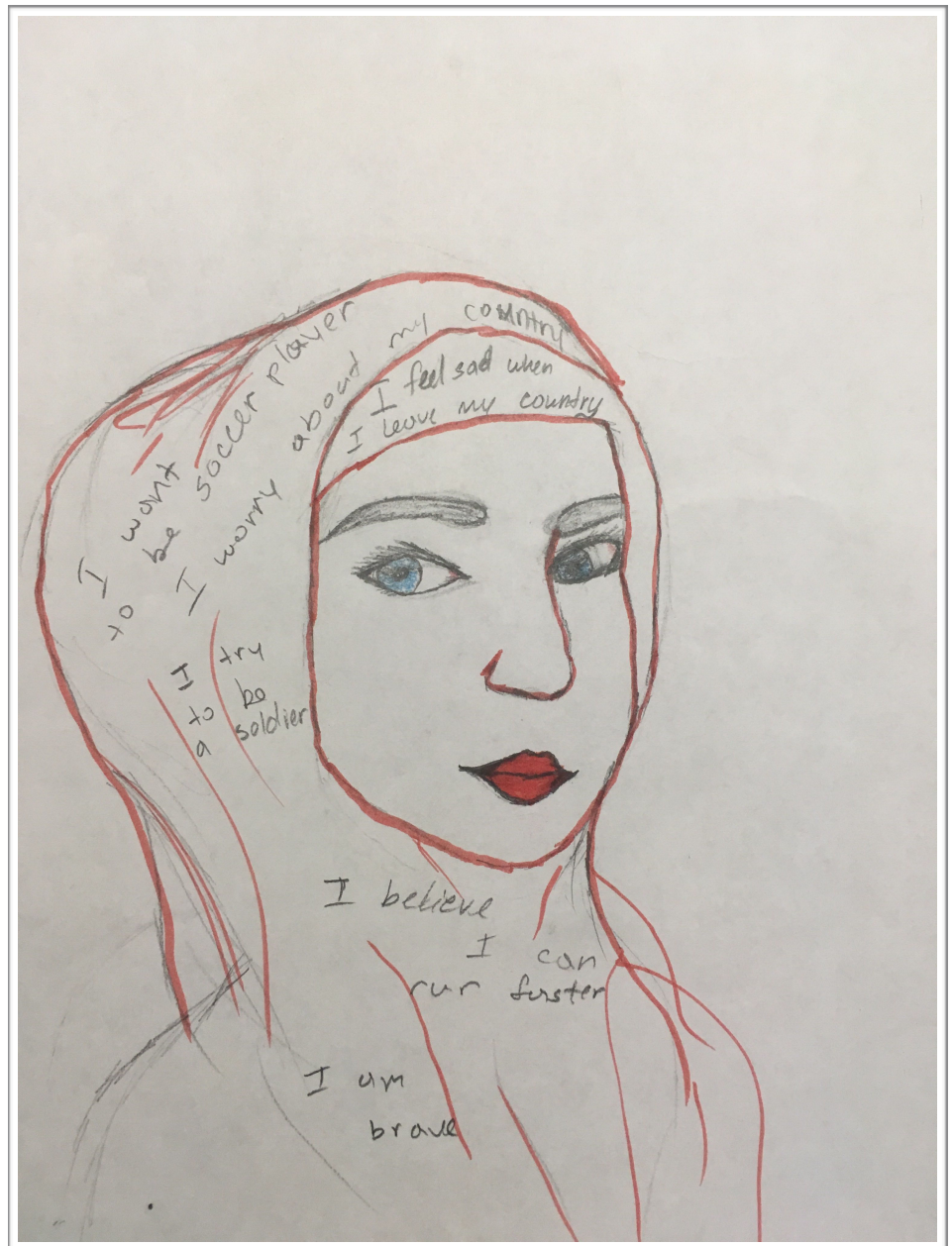
I am an honest and trustworthy person
