

Legal Team Intern and Extern Job Posting

HIAS Pennsylvania's legal department hosts law school and undergraduate students for semester-long unpaid internships and externships for credit. Interested applicants must be able to commit a minimum of 10 hours per week. Interested applicants must also be available to attend the initial onboarding session which is hosted at the start of each semester (September, January, and June).

In addition to a demonstrated interest and commitment to immigrant and refugee rights, applicants with foreign language skills (particularly, though not exclusively, Spanish) are highly preferred.

Successful applicants will be placed in our intake program and work under the supervision of our intake managing attorney where students will have the opportunity to screen new potential clients seeking legal services at HIAS Pennsylvania. This is a great opportunity to learn about immigration law and get first hand experience working with clients. In addition to work on intake, eligible candidates will be placed in one of our legal teams and have an opportunity to work on individual cases under the direct supervision of an attorney.
