

Don't Miss Your Immigration Court Hearing: Check Your Case Status Regularly!



WHAT IS A MEGA MASTER?

Many Immigration Courts are moving Master Calendar Hearings ("Master Hearings") to earlier dates and scheduling large group hearings that we are calling "Mega Masters."

If you miss your hearing, arrive late, or appear online when you were required to attend in person, an Immigration Judge may order you removed in absentia (deportation order in your absence) from the United States.

HOW TO CHECK YOUR HEARING DATE

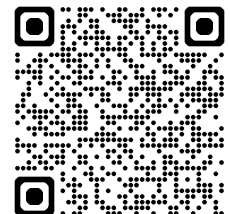
Check your hearing date weekly online or by phone to ensure the date of your hearing has not changed.

By Phone

- Call the EOIR Automated Case Information Hotline Number at 1-800-898-7180
- Available 24 hours a day in English and Spanish.
- When prompt enter your Alien Registration Number.

Online

- Visit <https://acis.eoir.justice.gov>.
- You will need your A-Number (Alien Registration Number). Enter only the numbers (do not enter the letter "A").

PROTECT YOURSELF

- Check your hearing date every week online or by phone.
- Keep your address updated with Immigration Court if you move. For more information visit <https://respondentaccess.eoir.justice.gov/en/forms/eoir33ic/>
- Read all notices carefully and pay attention to the hearing date, location, and whether you must appear in person.
- Arrive at least one hour early for your hearing.

IF YOU MISS A HEARING

Contact a qualified immigration attorney or accredited representative immediately. There may be deadlines to appeal or reopen your case, sometimes within 30 days of the judge's decision.
